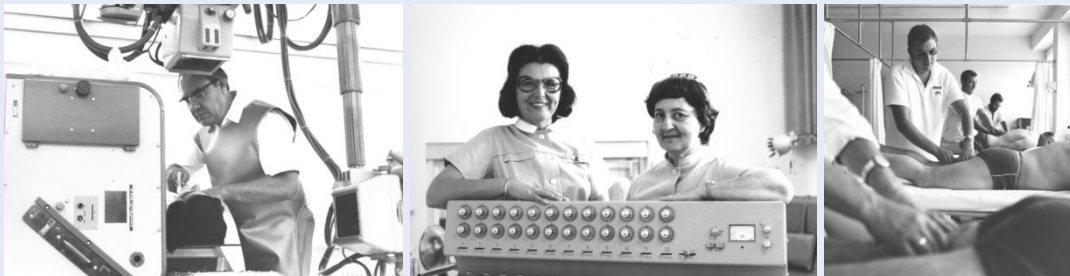
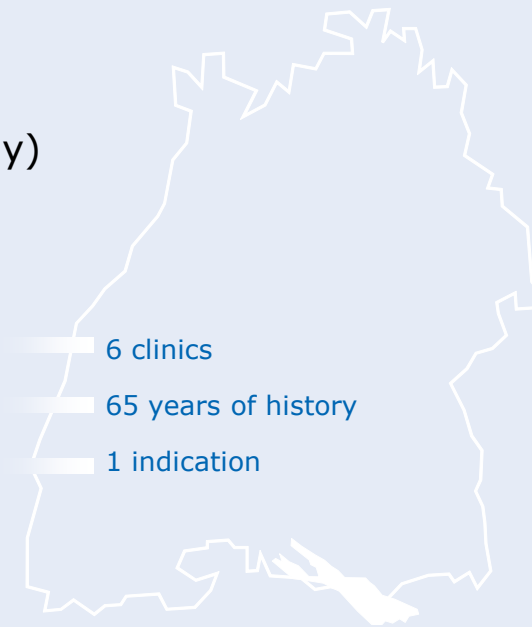

Treatment of acute as well as post-acute impairments due to brain injury after:

- Traumatic brain injuries
- Circulatory disturbances (strokes)
- Brain Tumors

- Damage to peripheral nerves

## Indications II

- All other acute and degenerative disorders of the central and peripheral nervous system
- Disorders of movement, e.g. Parkinsonism, dystonias, diseases of the muscles
- Psychological and psychosomatic disturbances associated with neurological diseases
- Neurological pain symptomatics
- Geriatric rehabilitation

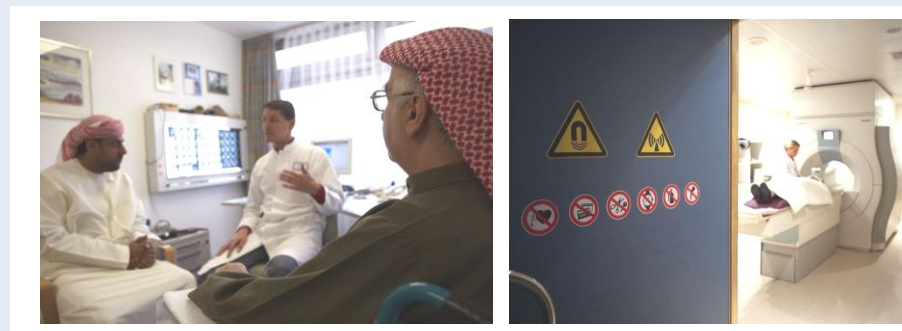

## Phase structure at Kliniken Schmieder

Phase	Description
NRPI	Stable ventilated patient or patient with intensive need for monitoring and nursing
NRPS	Barthel Index 0-30
NRPM	Barthel Index 35-100
NRPM (ambulant)	Barthel Index 80-100

- The price for NRPM includes 1 accompanying person (in the patient room)
- Basic external consultations are included



# What makes the treatment at Kliniken Schmieder special?
